

Congress Punts on Flood Insurance Reform...Again

On July 31, Congress passed a four-month extension of the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) just hours before it was set to expire at midnight. The legislation was the seventh short-term extension of the NFIP since September 2017. The NFIP program had to be extended, of course. Any lapse in NFIP coverage could have created disruptions in home sales and closings in many areas of the country.
